Overview

Aim to provide a safe and welcoming space where children be taken care of after school until they are collected by their parents

Objectives

- To provide a safe, secure environment at the end of the school day for children
- To allow children to play together and enjoys a range of craft activities
- To provide a calm environment with a quiet space should the children want to read quietly or complete their homework
- To ensure there is one member of qualified staff to care for the Early Years children
- To ensure consistent ratios are provided for children under three
- To ensure there is a service that includes all children from Nursery to Year

Procedures

Honeypots takes place in Nursery classroom between the hours of
 4.00pm to 6.00pm (The school reserves the right to reduce the hours if staffing is affected due to sickness)

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- It is managed by two staff, one of whom is a qualified Early Years member of staff, who are employed by the school
- The staff are made aware of the school safeguarding policy
- All children are registered when they arrive or when the Late Class teacher leaves
- All children are given the opportunity to take part in an organised activity
 each evening
- Where necessary children will be given the opportunity and support to complete their evening Prep including reading activities
- A light tea will be provided, which will be prepared by one member of staff whilst the children are supervised.
- All staff will have completed an up-to-date Food Handling course
- One member of staff will have attended a First Aid Training course
- A member of SLT will be available at all times whilst Honeypots takes
 place
- If a child is not collected by 6.00pm staff will attempt to contact the parents
- If they cannot be contacted the children will be taken to the main school house and the SLT member will be informed
- The procedures for uncollected children will be followed
